

Request for a public sewer under Section 101A of the Water Industry Act 1991

1. Introduction

With effect from 1 April 1996, Section 101A allows owners or occupiers of premises to request Severn Trent Water to provide a public sewer, for domestic purposes, where;

- 1.1. The sewer will serve more than one premise.
- 1.2. The premises are presently served by private drainage not directly or indirectly connected to an existing public sewer.
- 1.3. The existing drainage for dealing with sewage is giving, or is likely to give rise to adverse effects on the environment or amenity.

2. Costs

- 2.1. If the request is successful the public sewer will be provided at our cost.
- 2.2. You will be responsible for the cost and the future maintenance of your private connection to the public sewer.
- 2.3. The abandonment, and making safe, of the existing private drainage systems serving the premises will be the responsibility of, and at the cost of, individual premise occupiers or owners.
- 2.4. Once connected to public sewerage you will be liable for the sewerage infrastructure charge. Details will be provided on request.
- 2.5. Once your premises are connected to public sewerage you will become liable for annual sewerage charges. Details will be provided on request.


