Minutes of meeting of the Manafon Community Council held at New Mills Village Hall on Wednesday 4th July 2018 at 7.30 p.m.

Cllr J. Hall (Chair) welcomed everybody to the meeting.

Apologies (037) – Cllr. H. Hulme and Cllr. A. Lewis

Declaration of Interest (038) – Cllr. J. Davies declared an interest in New Mills village hall, as he is the Chairman.

Minutes of the last meeting (039) – It was proposed and seconded to sign the corrected minutes dated May 2nd 2018 and also sign minutes dated June 6th as a correct record.

Matters Arising (040) –

Future Fit – Cllr. Benyon had attended a recent meeting in Newtown, it was very interesting to be able to listen to the professionals. Cllr. Benyon agreed to write a piece for the messenger to encourage householders to have their say.

OVW – The next meeting was to be held on July 11th, Cllr. Hall would be unable to attend but Cllr. J. Davies advised he was able to go with Cllr. Prentice.

IRPW – The Clerk had drafted and circulated the letters which were all signed by members.

Correspondence Received (041) – Nil

Finance (042) – The Clerk presented the quarterly accounts which were noted by the Council.

Internet Banking (043) – It was proposed by Cllr. T. Jerman and seconded by Cllr. I. Prentice that the internet banking documents submitted by the Clerk be signed by the relevant signatures.

Grass Cutting – The grass cutting had not been done, Clerk to e-mail Clive at PCC to see when this would be actioned.

The Council were disappointed that after a site visit, the issues raised had still not been rectified and Cllr. C. Davies had had no contact, nor had the Clerk.

Large patches of tarmac had lifted between Ffinant and the lane to the Ford.

The road through the village was to be scraped and re-tarmaced.

A note to go in the messenger to remind house holders to put their recycling bins out every week, not just when they are full. This is causing the bin lorry to fill quicker and leaving it unable to collect all their collections.

Planning (045) - Nil

County Councillor's Report (047)- Cllr. Hulme was unable to attend but had asked Cllr. J. Davies to pass on that planning applications would only be notified to us if it is right on the boundary.

Also, Bugans hole was to be re-surfaced.

The Clerk had booked the hall and Cllr. Hall had obtained a map to be used. New Mills Village Hall Wifi (049) – Cllr. J. Hall had obtained various quotes ranging from £24.99 - £42.00 per month with different providers. The Council agreed that this be put on the agenda for September.
