Additional information - The Knife Angel will spend 28 days in the grounds of the Oriel Gallery Newtown from January 3RD 2020 to help raise awareness of knife and violent crimes, it is part of the police anti violence campaign, there will also be a knife/dangerous weapons amnesty where individuals can dispose safely any such items. Ash dieback disease is a growing concern in the county which will subsequently create a large project of removal for the county.

Mid Wales growth development plan will see funding of £55 million over 15 years, Powys and Ceredigion councils will be working together alongside other neighbouring county councils to develop ideas and understand the stumbling blocks to business developments.
